Superintendent News

As we enter the last month of the school year, I would like to remind you to please check the district website for the many events that are going to happen as we conclude our present school year. Two such events are graduation, which is set for Sunday, May 19, 2019 at 1:00 pm and the last day of school for students, which is Friday, May 24, 2019 with a dismissal time of 1:00 pm.

I would like to thank the following staff who will be retiring at the conclusion of this school year: Ken Baldauf, School bus driver (14 years), Diane Chambers (9 years) who actually retired in July of 2018, Dorothy Ditsworth, Head Cook (19 years), Mike Strohecker School Bus Driver (14.5 years) who actually retired in August of 2018, and Chris Wallace, Elementary Principal (18 years). Their commitment/dedication to the students of Pearl City has been a big part of why Pearl City Schools is an exceptional school. Thank you and good luck in your future endeavors.

As I write my last newsletter as the superintendent of the school, I have had a chance to reflect on the 47 years I have been part of the Pearl City School system (35 years as a teacher and administrator and 12 years as a student). I can honestly tell you that I have truly enjoyed those years while serving the Pearl City Community.

While acting as the superintendent, I always strived to ensure that the students of Pearl City received the highest possible education, that we always employed the best possible teachers and staff, and to make sure that the District always remained financially sound. I leave knowing that I helped accomplish each of these goals. As a tribute to our staff, our students continually receive a high quality education. The student success post high school and our test scores continually demonstrate this year in and year out. Financially, the school has maintained sound fund balances, in spite of perhaps the worst seven years of funding (lack of or reduced funding) provided by the State of Illinois. Fund balances are only slightly lower than they were when I started as superintendent twelve years ago. In spite of these difficulties, the district has never had to ask the community for additional money in the form of any bond since the construction bond in 2000. Note - this year's tax payment is the last payment you will be making on this bond and yes your 2020 tax bill will be going down significantly. Serving as the superintendent until this bond was completely paid has always been a major goal of mine. Moving forward, finances will continue to be a concern, but if the State makes good on the new Evidence Based Funding at 100% (they are presently paying us at 68%) and makes all obligated payments as scheduled, Pearl City Schools will not have to worry about the finances.

I want to thank the Board of Education for giving me a shot by hiring me as a teacher back in 1984 and being a great Board while acting as superintendent. To all of past and present teaching colleagues who truly care about our school and students. To all the support staff for making our school operate efficiently. To all the past and present administrators I have been fortunate to work with especially Chris Wallace who for 17 years together, helped bring a lasting stability and provided outstanding leadership to our school. To the entire Pearl City community for always supporting an outstanding school and finally and most importantly to all the students who have created the memories that I will cherish and carry with me for the rest of my life. You truly are the reason that we do what we do. THANK YOU Everyone!!!!

I wish nothing but the best for the entire school district and the Pearl City community.
