Board of Education Meeting Updates

During its meeting on Oct. 16th, 2019, the PCSD 200 Board of Education:

Heard presentation from Dr. Schiffman on the Finance Process and Bond sale. A representative was also at the meeting to answer questions for the school board members. Dr. Schiffman also held a Community Forum on the Finance Process on Oct. 23rd from 6:00pm to 7:00pm in the School Cafeteria. - Heard information on moving back to a JH Tackle Football Program for the 2020-2021 season. The school board will bring this back to the Nov. board meeting.
- Representatives from the Village of Pearl City came to discuss the possibility of a road from the back parking lot to Rt. 73. The board will bring this back to the agenda in November.
- Approved a Coop Track Agreement with Lena-Winslow for Boys Track for the 2019-2020 and 2020-2021 track season. (However, at the Oct.22 Lena-Winslow board meeting the agreement was voted down by the Lena-Winslow School Board).
- Approved to move forward with the Softball field renovations and also to have the district budget up to \$1,000 to help with the renovations.

- Approved Resignation of Jennifer Plastiak
- Approved Elizabeth Schroeder Torres and Gretchen Shallenberger as JH/HS Paraprofessionals

NOTES & REMINDERS

Working Cash Bond Sale

The PCUSD is looking to sell bonds and place in the working cash fund. The purpose of a bond sale is to allow the borrower to spend money right away and then pay it back over time. School districts use bonds to borrow money to pay for expenses that maybe short-term projects. The reason for the bond sale is to help with the facilities and maintain the operating funds in the district. The district is in need of about \$760,000 in total roof repairs. There are also several state mandates that will require additional funds (salary increases, minimum wage increases, pension reform). Legislation is also discussing the possibilities of a property tax freeze.

The current bond that PCUSD has will be paid off with the current tax levy. Currently, a property owner with a EAV of \$100,000 pays about \$358. With the WC Bond a property owner with a EAV of \$100,000 would pay approximately \$58. This is a difference and savings of \$300/\$100,000 EAV. The bond sale could bring in approximately \$1.5 million in revenue for the school district.

The surrounding communities have always been great supporters of the PCUSD. The district asks that the communities continue to see the school district as a positive investment rather than an expense.

How is the school communicating?


