During its meeting on Sept. 25th, 2019, the PCSD 200 Board of Education:

- Approved facility use for Extreme Volleyball Club

- Discussed having a road from Rt. 73 to the back school parking lot. The school board will wait to see a plan from the Village of Pearl City before moving forward with further discussion.

- Discussion to move forward with a plan for e-learning days instead of emergency days. Administration will begin working with teachers on a plan.

Immunizations

A student is required by state law to have proof of immunizations against, and screenings, for, preventable communicable diseases as required by the Illinois Dept. of Public Health, unless an exemption or extension applies. The failure to comply with the above requirements by October 15th of the current school year will result in a student's exclusion from school until the required health forms are presented to the District.
