The State Board of Education will post the 2019 District Report Card, on Nov. 1<sup>st</sup>, at <u>www.illinoisreportcard.com</u>. You can also access the report card by going to our district website by clicking on District Information and then click on School Report Card. This will take you directly to all of our school and District data. The data on the report card includes student and teacher demographics, enrollment, district-level financial information. 5Essential Survey information, graduation rates, postsecondary enrollment and freshmen on track. The Report Card will showcase new metrics and features to show a more complete picture of school climate and students' progress toward college and career readiness. Data involving student academic growth and achievement will be included in this release. This data will be based on student, school, and district-level IAR and SAT test results.

The 5 Essential Survey will again be conducted this school year. The window to complete the survey is from November- January. The parent survey will be open and is to be completed by parents, guardians, or other caregivers with a child in grades PreK-12. The parent survey is available in English and Spanish and takes approximately 10 minutes to complete. If parents have more than one child that attends the same school, they may elect to participate multiple times. For parents with children enrolled in multiple schools, we recommend that they participate in the survey for each school building their child attends. There will be no extra yearbooks ordered so get your order in today! The LAST day to order a yearbook is March 22, 2020.


