The State Board of Education will post the 2020 District Report Card, on Nov. 1<sup>st</sup>, at [www.illinoisreportcard.com](http://www.illinoisreportcard.com). You can also access the report card by going to our district website by clicking on District Information and then click on School Report Card. This will take you directly to all of our school and District data. The data on the report card includes student and teacher demographics, enrollment, district-level financial information, 5Essential Survey information, graduation rates, postsecondary enrollment and freshmen on track. The Report Card will showcase new metrics and features to show a more complete picture of school climate and students' progress toward college and career readiness. Data involving student academic growth and achievement will be included in this release. This data will be based on student, school, and district-level IAR and SAT test results. Please also understand that some of the data will be incomplete because of the school closures due to the COVID pandemic.

### E-Learning Plan

In Illinois you never know what the weather is going to do. So, I wanted to start sharing our e-Learning plan this month so you are all prepared. Last year, the Pearl City School Board approved the use of e-Learning days to replace severe weather or emergency days. Therefore, instead of having a snow day and going later into the school year the district will utilize the e-Learning Plan. This plan is similar to a Remote Learning Day. The district will still utilize the School Messenger system to notify parents of the e-Learning Day. 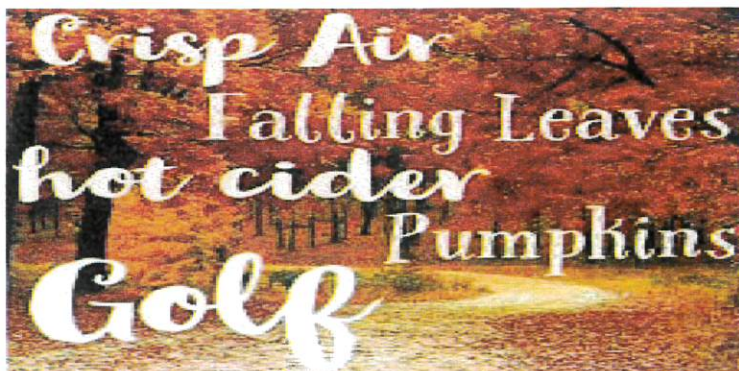

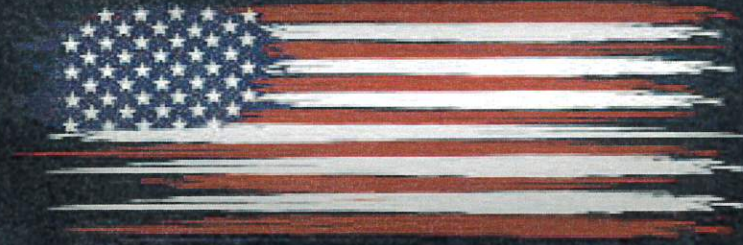
