5 Essentials Survey

Beginning January 11, 2022 and running through March 11, 2022, all parents, certified teachers and students in grades 6-12 are asked to participate in a short survey on school climate and learning conditions. The State Board of Education requires all Illinois schools to participate in the Illinois 5 Essentials Survey to guide local and state improvement initiatives.

The parent survey is to be completed by parents, guardians, or other caregivers with a child in grades prekindergarten through 12. The parent survey is available in English and Spanish and takes approximately 10 minutes to complete. If you have more than 1 child and they attend the same school, you may elect to participate multiple times. Parents with children enrolled in multiple schools may participate in the survey for each school. Only one parent per household may participate in the survey.

Pearl City Schools is asking all parents to take the time to complete the survey. Information collected from the survey provides insight that guides future improvement planning.

#### **Spring State Testing**

Spring is in the air and that means the students and teachers are preparing for the State exams. This is the third year Illinois has participated in the IAR assessment. The test will be administered to students in grades 3-8. The 2022 exam has a simpler format to improve the testing process while still providing reliable information about student achievement. This year's results will allow parents, teachers, and students to see how the student is growing in his or her knowledge and understanding of the state's learning standards, which are focused on college and career readiness.

Since the Spring of 2020, ISBE requires all public-school students in grade 9 to take the PSAT 8/9 and all public-school students in grade 10 to take the PSAT 10. ISBE will continue to require all public-school students in grade 11 to take the SAT. These tests will again show the school and student areas of strength and areas to improve upon. For the Juniors, the SAT will play an important part in their college acceptance and also scholarship opportunities.

No assessment can ever fully capture the skills and abilities of a great teacher or the extraordinary benefits and positive impact of a great school. These assessments are simply one reflection of your child's academic growth. Assessments help provide a sense of where and how we are succeeding and where and how we must improve, along with other indicators, such as classroom work samples and teacher observations. The IAR and SAT assessments are

designed to give schools and teachers more information to support improvement efforts and personalize teaching to better guide our students' learning. These spring assessments correspond with what the students are learning in the classroom and with the performance expectations of the Illinois Learning Standards in English Language Arts and Mathematics.

Ways you can help your child with IAR and SAT testing:

Offer practice exercises and questions that are similar to those that may be on the test. The school has provided several resources such as:

- When practicing with your child focus on their weakest areas in order to strengthen this area and to build their confidence when taking the actual test. Please contact your child's teacher for more information.
- Keep practice sessions short and if your child becomes frustrated stop the session.
- Be sure your child gets a good night sleep
- Eat a healthy breakfast
- Share the importance of the exam with your child. This test will help gauge the learning level of your child. Encourage them "To Do Your Best on the Test!"
- Help your child stay calm the day of the test


Main Office.

The Pearl City Education Foundation will be awarding scholarships to full time students at Honors Night but only to those who apply. The due date for applications is April 1, mailed to PCEF, Box 278, Pearl City, IL 61062. The application form is available from the guidance counselor, the completed form also requires a transcript from the guidance counselor or school registrar. Last year \$20,000 was awarded. If you are a sophomore or junior and wish to attend HCC next school year, soon you will need to apply to HCC and receive the necessary forms from Pearl City High School well ahead of classes beginning in August. PCEF helps with tuition and books for CollegeNOW.
