It is hard to believe that we are now in the 4th quarter of the school year. This time of year is filled with activities and testing to include our state assessments (IAR (Grades 3-8); Science assessment (Grades 5, 8, 11); PSAT (Grade 9,10) and SAT (Grade 11) and our local assessments (AimsWeb and MAP). The Board of Education held their monthly meeting of which a summary can be found on our district website. The main topic of discussion involved the first reading of the Parent/Student handbook. There were only a couple of changes to the handbook for next year. Also the board approved to move forward with a Summer School Program which would begin on May 31st and run through June 16th. The board also heard the first reading of School Fees for the 2022-2023 school year. There was a recommendation to increase the price of both breakfast and lunch by .15 cents. There is also a recommend to increase the Technology Fee by \$5.00. Junior High Promotion and Retention Policy

As a reminder, I have included the guidelines that will be used for this policy.

The decision as to pupil placement (retention or acceleration) shall be made by the school principal after careful consideration of the following:

- Teacher Recommendation
- Attendance
- Grades
- A student who fails their grade level benchmarks will be considered for retention. Grade Level Benchmarks are the very minimum skills required for students.
- A student who fails mathematics or reading for the year will be required to attend summer school or will be retained at current grade level.



PCEF Offers \$20,000 in Upperclassman Scholarships for 2021-2022 School Year

Pearl City Education Foundation announces availability of \$20,000 to fund Pearl City Upperclassman Scholarships for full-time College or Trade School students for the upcoming 2021-2022 school year. Senior Honors

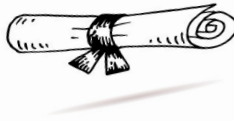
