Dear Parents, Guardians, and Community Members,

The school year has reached the mid-way point. There have been some advances to our curriculum, building and grounds, teaching strategies, schedules and the way our students are learning. However, the one thing that has not changed is the commitment and dedication of the entire Pearl City School District educational staff. They continue to strive for excellence and they continue to prepare all students to make positive contributions in an ever-changing world.

#### **E-Learning Days for Severe weather**

As we prepare to enter the winter season we will be notifying students and families of e-Learning days (instead of closures), delays, early releases via the District calling system (School Messenger), website, local TV stations and local radio station. We will try to have our message out to everyone the night before or between 5:30am and 6:00am. Please remember that the district will be utilizing e-Learning days instead of closing for snow days or cold days. Students should log into their Chromebook and sign in for attendance. Teachers will have work prepared for students in case of the need for the e-Learning day. The school day will be from 8:30-1:30. #### Levy

The Pearl City School Board approved the tax levy at the November board meeting. This year's levy is asking for an 8.65% increase. Please understand that the district does not receive what we ask for in the levy, the district receives CPI (8.7%) or a maximum of 5%, whichever is less. Levying a higher rate ensures that the district will also receive any increases in EAV and any new construction.

### <u>Curriculum</u>

The Pearl City School District is continuing to update and improve the curriculum of the district. This year the district has implemented a new K-12 Science, 7-12 Agriculture Curriculum, 9-12 Foreign Language curriculum. The district is also researching and looking to implement a new curriculum in the areas of Fine Arts and elementary Social Science for the 2023-2024 school year. Select teachers will be piloting the sampled curriculum during the third and fourth quarter. The new curriculums would focus on a digital learning platform. The curriculum will also focus on a tier system of learning. A tiered system would allow students to work and succeed at their individual levels. The new curriculum will be purchased using the Federal grant that was received last year.

### **Building and Grounds**

The Pearl City School District School Board approved a HVAC project for completion this summer. The district's steam boilers are over 75 years old. The steam boilers and the copper pipes have started to break down on a consistent basis. The District will reduce the stress of the boilers by putting in a new HVAC system in the High School wing and office area of the school. With the new ductwork and piping the District will also redo the High School Hallway ceiling and lighting. The project will be funded through a Federal Grant, State Grant and then by utilizing funds from the Health Life Safety funds. The project bid came in at \$641,900 and was awarded to Loeschers Heating and Cooling.

There continues to be a lot of positive changes to the Pearl City School District. We continue to look forward to sharing these changes as the year progresses. year-old girl" could really be any age from anywhere in the world!

 If a phone contact is not made, office staff will call the students parent/ guardians by 10:00 am.


