Students, Staff, Parents, and Community Members,

The world of Education is always changing and should continue to adapt to the way students learn. Sometimes as adults we do not always understand these changes because simply put "That is not the way I learned it!" Adults would be correct in this statement, but we need to realize the way we learned is not the best way for our children to learn, in today's world. Because of advancements in the field of technology roughly 70% of our students will have careers that do not even exist yet. This is the challenge we face as a school and district. To provide our kids with the best education, we must also prepare them for the future by providing and teaching them with research-based teaching strategies, rigorous standards, and the best possible tools to go out in the world and be successful. The vision statement for the Pearl City School District is to promote educational excellence in a positive environment to inspire life-long learning and responsible citizenship. Below are a few ways that we are doing this in the Pearl City School District

Curriculum

Over the past four years the Pearl City School District has implemented new curriculum in all academic areas. The most recent implementation was with Science, Foreign Language, Agriculture, Fine Arts, and Business. The curricula are all research-based curricula that was selected by a committee of teachers and administration. The teachers have also taken professional development in order to help with a smooth transition of the new curriculum. The Pearl City School District will now update the curriculum timeline and begin to review each of the implemented curriculums to ensure the curricula are having a positive effect on the student's academic success. The new curricula is just one of the tools students and teachers will utilize to ensure academic success.

School Messenger

Pearl City School District is utilizing the School Messenger automated notification system for families, parents, and/or guardians of children attending Pearl City Elementary School, Pearl City Jr/Sr. High School, Pearl City PASS Program, and Pearl City DayCare Center. School Messenger allows the Superintendent to record a brief message, which can be sent to parents simultaneously. Once the message is recorded, it only takes a few minutes to distribute. The system can be used if school is canceled for the day or if school is dismissed early. If you have any questions concerning the SchoolMessenger emergency notification system or would like a different contact number to be called, please contact your child's building office administrator or administrative assistant.

Building and Grounds

The district has completed a large project that started this summer. The district has upgraded its HVAC system in the HS wing of the school district. This project is being paid for by the Federal ESSER III grant and also Health Life Safety funds from the budget. The work is being Completed by the Loescher Heating and Air Company. Loescher installed the ductwork and supports per the original design but after further inspection the concrete block walls did not satisfactory support the ductwork

and they found a safer way to reinstall the support of the ductwork. They have gone above and beyond to help with this project. Since the air units were delayed Loescher also lent the district portable air conditioners to help with the beginning of the year heat wave. The district also remodeled the main hallway with new drywall, paint, and lights. The Heating and Air Units and project will be completed this Fall and Winter.

The school district also wrote a grant with Com Ed. to replace all of the current light fixtures and bulbs in the district with LED lights. This grant is through Com Ed. The replacement of fixtures and bulbs is almost complete. The company is finishing up in the coming weeks with the baseball, recess and football lights. Not only will the school district be brighter but it will be more efficient and save us on Electrical costs. All of this work was done at no cost to the school district.

Finances

The district is proud to let the parents and community know that this year the district has a balanced budget. This is an important step for the school district and the community. However, we also need to be aware of the financial mandates that are being added to the school districts in the coming years. District funds remain low in the categories of Operation and Maintenance and Transportation. Even with financial concerns, the district has continued to move forward by enhancing educational opportunities in the classrooms. We will continue to provide the best educational opportunities for the students with the funding we receive.

Parent-Teacher Conferences

Conferences will be held Wednesday, October 25th from 2:30 pm-7:30pm, and Thursday, October 26th from 2:30 pm- 7:30 pm. No school on October 27th. Please reach out to your child's teacher to begin scheduling a conference time that will work for you. Parent-Teacher conferences give teachers and parents the opportunity to discuss the academic progress, behavior, and social skill development as well as progress towards meeting the grade level benchmarks. Parents have the opportunity to share valuable insights about the child's interest, study skill and homework habits. Together, parents and teachers can work toward making the school year a positive learning experience. The key to a successful conference is preparation-for both the teacher and the parent. Even if the conference is a few weeks away, begin to think about it now. Ask your child what is going well at school and if they have any concerns. Write down questions and prioritize them in case you run short on time. You may want to take notes at the conference, especially if there are things that the teacher asks you to do with your child at home. Remember, the Parent-Teacher Conference is only one way to communicate about your child's progress: notes, phone calls, online through Skyward, and email are also ways to continue to communicate with your child's teacher.
