Dear Parents, Guardians, and Community Members,

The school year has reached the mid-way point. There have been some advances to our curriculum, building and grounds, teaching strategies, schedules and the way our students are learning. However, the one thing that has not changed is the commitment and dedication of the entire Pearl City School District educational staff. They continue to strive for excellence and they continue to prepare all students to make positive contributions in an ever-changing world.

E-Learning Days for Severe weather

As we prepare to enter the winter season we will be notifying students and families of e-Learning days (instead of closures), delays, early releases via the District calling system (School Messenger), website, local TV stations and local radio station. We will try to have our message out to everyone the night before or between 5:30am and 6:00am. Please remember that the district will be utilizing e-Learning days instead of closing for snow days or cold days. Students should log into their Chromebook and sign in for attendance. Teachers will have work prepared for students in case of the need for the e-Learning day. The school day will be from 8:30-1:30. Levy

The Pearl City School Board approved the tax levy at the November board meeting. This year's levy is asking for an 8.73% increase. Please understand that the district does not receive what we ask for in the levy, the district Receives CPI (6.95%) or a maximum of 5%, whichever is less. Levying a higher rate ensures that the district will also receive any increases in EAV and any new construction.

Curriculum

The Pearl City School District is continuing to update and improve the curriculum of the district. This year the district has implemented a new Fine Arts Curriculum. The district is also researching and looking to implement new curriculum in the area of elementary Social Science for the 2024-2025 school year. The new curriculums would focus on a digital learning platform. The curriculums will also focus on a tier system of learning. A tiered system would allow students to work and succeed at their individual levels. The district has also implemented a tiered learning system. The system will allow students additional small group and one-on-one time with a teacher to focus on specific areas of concern. Other students will work on strengthening their academic skills while working on enrichment opportunities. We believe this extra support and enrichment will truly benefit all students in the district.

Building and Grounds

The Pearl City School District is finalizing the construction of the new HVAC in the high school section of the school district. The final HVAC unit should arrive in January. The next big building and operation projects will be identified from the 10 year Health Life Safety Survey that will be completed at the end of the 2024-2025 school year. Some of the items we are anticipating will be safety doors for classrooms, updated security system and cameras, updated doors to the weight room and gym. The school district has done a great job throughout the years maintaining the building.

There continues to be a lot of positive changes to the Pearl City School District. We continue to look forward to sharing these changes as the year progresses. 
High School Volunteer Hours
